1. Create an HTML form that asks the user for their name. Minimally, the form should have a textbox `<input type="text">` and a button. Remember to give the textbox a name. When the user clicks the button, use a `window.alert` to greet the user by name. (This is a single line of code. Initially, put it directly in the button tag, the value for `onclick`.) Write the code for your form below.

2. Add a script tag to your HTML page. In the script tag, write a function that will the button `onclick` will call. This function should greet the user by name using a `window.alert`. Verify that it works. (Since this code is no longer in the form, you may have to change some of the naming you used.)

3. Update your function to blank out the textbox, in addition to greeting the user. Write the code for your updated function below.

4. Change the textbox from `<input type="text" ...>` to `<input type="password" ...>`. What is the effect of this change? (After this task, change it back to `type="text"`.)
